Subject: **Provider Letter 11-37** – Skilled Nursing Services in an ALF

Senate Bill 7, 82nd Legislature, First Called Session, 2011, amended Section 247.002 of the Health and Safety Code (HSC) and revised the definition of an ALF to authorize an ALF to use its staff to provide skilled nursing services for the following four limited purposes:

- 1) coordination of resident care with outside home and community support services agencies and other health care professionals;
- 2) provision or delegation of personal care services and medication administration as described in HSC Section 247.002;
- 3) assessment of residents to determine the care required; and
- 4) delivery of temporary skilled nursing treatment for a minor illness, injury, or emergency for periods of time as established by department rule.

Senate Bill 7 also amended Section 247.067 of the HSC to expressly authorize a facility to employ a health care professional to provide authorized services to residents at the facility that are within the professional's scope of practice. Note: The terms "health care professional," "personal care services," and "medication administration," used above, are defined in [HSC Chapter 247](#) or Texas Administrative Code, Title 40, Part 1, Subsection 92.2, [Licensing Standards for Assisted Living Facilities](#) or both.

The provisions of Senate Bill 7 summarized above are effective September 28, 2011. The Department of Aging and Disability Services will be establishing by department rule the periods of time when an ALF may deliver temporary skilled nursing treatment for a minor illness, injury, or emergency.
